Here are a few other things we will need to know and confirm before we ship anything or anyone back to set up your spray system. It doesn't benefit either party for us to show up and not have everything ready for us to be there. Our time is best spent focusing on the setup and or training when we arrive. Please read through this questionnaire and Initial the areas need confirmation that they were read and addressed. Please fill in the areas that have been left blank and require information from you.

We discussed that the setup portion is included with the system with training at our facility. We also discussed doing the setup and you paying for the expenses for an extra tech (Spray Applicator Tech) to do the spray training at the time of the system setup. If this option is chosen you will be charged for his flight, food, lodging and wage for our spray tech after the setup is complete. Cost wise it is about the same as sending someone to train at our facility. There is a big advantage to sending your applicator to our facility to train. The shop that they would be in is a very high production facility that averages over 400 trucks a month. Not every applicator does things the same way. Some guys might mask a little different and some might sand or spray a little different. This would enable them to experience different techniques from different applicators. They can then go back to their shop with different option/techniques from their training session and choose the ones that work best for them in your shop.

When setting up the booth please refer to page 9 in the booklet. These booth dimensions shown on page 9 represent the Ideal booth space 20'W x 25'L with a ceiling style top. You could get away with a 15'W x 20'L with a ceiling style top but it is kind of a tight space as you will have the tailgate off the truck on stands at the back of the booth. Remember the idea of the booth is for safety of the applicator as well as personnel outside of the spray booth so it must also have negative air flow though the booth. This will help confine any overspray to the booth area. Keep in mind there is no need to reinvent the wheel so to speak when it comes to the booth. The design in the drawing on page 9 in the booklet works and works very well. We will require photos of the outside and inside of your booth once constructed.

What will your booth dimensions be? _____

The exhaust fan size will depend on the booth size (cubic feet of air within the booth). What you are looking for is 1 air turnaround/exchange of air every 2 minutes. If you contact a HVAC guy they can calculate this for you. Initial: _____
